This is a unique cultural event! Please come with an open mind, prepared to learn about and experience fully the entire creative and spiritual process just as it has been done for ages within the tribal community. You will not just “make a craft project,” but create an authentic medicine bag to wear around your neck or to give to a special person. This is a rare opportunity to learn about a traditional craft from a native artist.

Arthur Robert Long Bohn, a tribal member of the Menominee Nation, was given the gift of creating medicine bags by his elders on his reservation. This native artist believes that every medicine bag is connected to the spirit world and works as a spirit helper in which the four directions are known to cover your spiritual, mental, physical, and emotional being. When your medicine bag is done, Arthur smudges your medicine bag in prayer and asks creator to look down on us all in great favor and bless us all. Arthur does not take any of the credit for the good medicine that will come from your medicine bag, but believes that he is a channel that the creator can work through.
